The Associate of Applied Science Degree and the Certificate of Achievement in Hotel, Restaurant and Casino Management are designed to provide the student with an opportunity to seek employment in entry level supervisory positions or, for those currently employed in the hotel, restaurant and casino industries, an opportunity for job advancement, professional growth and career mobility. The student may continue his or her studies at a four year institution to pursue a baccalaureate degree.
