ABOUT THE SCHOOL

EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY

Casino Gaming School is dedicated to providing every student the finest in classroom and personal training, to assure that every graduate possesses the knowledge and skills necessary for a qualified casino dealer.

SCHOOL FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

The school has an administrative office and a casino-style classroom with the following equipment: one Roulette table, 8 Blackjack tables, 2 Craps tables, 1 Poker table, one Mini-Baccarat table, 1 Pai Gow table and one Pai Gow Poker table.

CLASS SIZE

In keeping with our educational philosophy, classes are restricted to 35 students maximum. In Pai Gow Poker we consider maximum student to teacher load to be 14 to 1; in Pai Gow 6 to 1; in Baccarat 4 to 1; in Poker 9 to 1; in Craps 10 to 1; in Roulette and Blackjack 25 to 1. In the event students enroll in a particular class exceeding these ratios, temporary full-time instructors will be added.

LICENSE

G.G.S. is licensed by the Commission on Post Secondary Education in the State of Nevada.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES

Each student is personally interviewed by the Admissions Representative, who will explain the School's philosophy, discuss the opportunities in the Gaming Industry and explain the course contents.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

C.G.S. accepts as students those individuals who have graduated from high school; have passed the General Education Development test (GED); or are above the compulsory age of school attendance and have the *ability to benefit* from the training C.G.S. offers. The prospective student should also be in good health, should have no major physical handicaps that would hinder his/her ability to deal and should display sufficient manual dexterity to become an employable graduate.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

ENROLLMENT

Students may enroll at any time during the year. Classes start every day; Monday through Friday, and end when the time and course requirements have been fulfilled. The ending date may vary from student to student because of circumstances such as advanced credit and class repeats. Enrollment is restricted to availability of classes. Our classes are limited in size to insure that every student is given the individual instruction needed to become an employable graduate; therefore, when that limit is reached, enrollment in that class is closed until room is available.
