

University of Nevada, Las Vegas

While the University is relatively young, it has experienced rapid growth in recent years. Student enrollment has reached 24,000, and approximately 7,000 of those are graduate students. The University of Nevada, Las Vegas is located on a 335-acre campus, less than two miles from McCarran International Airport. The Lied Library, completed in 2001, has become the center of the UNLV campus. This 300,000 sq. ft. facility has the capacity to store 1.8 million volumes, offers 24-hour study space and utilizes state-of-the-art technology, including the Automated Storage and Retrieval System (ASRS). More than half of the 2,500 study spaces are equipped with full network connections.

The Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching now ranks UNLV as a Doctoral/Research University-Intensive, the organization's second-highest ranking. Recently, UNLV was ranked 10th out of 25 doctoral universities whose graduates incurred the least debt load. In addition, UNLV is among the most affordable institutions of higher education.
